

DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM

The Dress Code of Edenhope College applies during school hours, whilst travelling to and from the College, and when students are engaged in College activities out of school hours. The written requirements of the Dress Code take precedence over any student's individual preference in matters of dress.

Boys' Uniform

Shorts/Trousers:	P – 4 grey elastic waist 5 – 12 grey tailored
Shirt:	royal blue polo shirt that may have 'Edenhope College' embroidered in gold; long or short sleeve
Socks:	plain white, grey or navy ankle length socks
Shoes:	black with closed toes and heels (no thongs or scuffs)
Jumper:	navy blue with lemon and blue stripe, wool blend
Jacket:	royal blue and gold with College logo. May be worn as an alternative to the College jumper.
Broad-brimmed hat:	Terms 1 and 4 compulsory (encouraged year round)

Girls' Uniform

Dress:	checked school dress
Skirt:	navy box pleated skirt (Midford only)
Shorts/Slacks:	P – 4 navy elastic waist 5 – 12 navy tailored
Belt:	navy
Socks:	plain white, grey or navy ankle length socks
Shirt:	royal blue polo shirt that may have 'Edenhope College' embroidered in gold; long or short sleeve
Shoes:	black with closed toes and heels (no thongs or scuffs)
Jumper:	navy blue with lemon and blue stripe, wool blend
Jacket:	royal blue and gold with logo (may be worn as an alternative to the College jumper)
Broad-brimmed hat:	Terms 1 and 4

Junior School

Students may wear any of the above or navy track suit pants and/or windcheater.

Sports Uniform: (when representing the College)

Boys Football	jumper, royal blue College supplied shorts, blue and gold socks
Girls Netball	royal blue netball skirt, College supplied shirt – gold polo or T-shirt, white socks
Tracksuits	navy blue with College logo
Jackets	optional, Sports Service brand, lined jacket with College logo, royal blue, gold and navy
Athletics	navy basketball shorts, gold polo or T-shirt singlets
House Sports	House colours - mid blue, gold polo top or T-shirt
Physical Education	a suitable change of clothing and sports shoes

Year 10 students design a VCE jumper each year that is approved by College Council and ordered through the College.

OUT OF UNIFORM

If a student is temporarily unable to comply with the Dress Code, parents are to provide an explanatory note via the Home Group teacher. The student will be given an out of uniform pass.

EXEMPTIONS FROM THE DRESS CODE

Exemptions from the Dress Code may be considered on grounds of religious belief, ethnic or cultural background, disability, health condition or economic hardship.

Any application for exemptions shall be addressed to and considered by the College Principal. Results of such applications are made known to a subsequent College Council meeting.

CASUAL CLOTHES DAYS

On special days where the Students' Representative Council has an approved a casual clothes day for fundraising purposes the following rules apply:

- no thongs;
- no singlet tops or crop tops; and
- no t-shirts or jeans with slogans that contain offensive language.

HATS

Edenhope College is a SunSmart school. The College Council has endorsed the wearing of broad-brimmed hats in the playground.

This is enforced in the Junior School through “*No Hat, No Play*”.

Middle and Senior School students must wear broad-brimmed hats during recess and lunch times, and during outdoor PE, Sport and excursion activities, in Terms 1 and 4.

Students not wearing a broad-brimmed hat must remain in the shade.

Students are also encouraged to use 15+ Sunblock.
