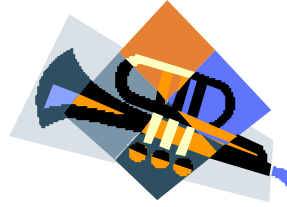
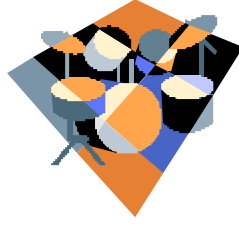
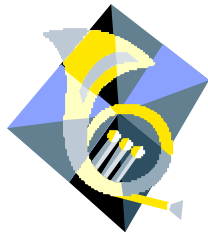

## 2009 INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

Edenhope College highly values creativity. A variety of opportunities is provided for students to participate and excel in the Performing Arts.

A key area of opportunity in the Performing Arts at Edenhope College is our Instrumental Music Program. The staffing of this program is 75% funded by the Grampians Region of the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development, with a further 25% supplement to our allocation being funded by the College.

The College's Instrumental Music Teacher, Mr Dennis Pearson, provides tuition in woodwind, brass, percussion, strings and guitar. Mrs Ruth Pfitzner provides piano lessons on a private fee paying basis.

### LESSONS



Each music student will have one group teaching session per week. There is no additional cost for the lesson. There is a requirement for the students to attend Concert Band rehearsals and performances and to take an active part in the Band when they have reached an appropriate level of proficiency on their instrument.

The music timetable is re-organised every term and each student will be absent from the same class every week during any particular term to attend their music lesson.

Band members are expected to practise for a half hour each night, as well as attend rehearsals at school. Rehearsals for the Senior Band are during Friday lunchtimes from 1.00pm and after school until 5.00pm on Tuesdays. Junior Band rehearsals are during Tuesday lunchtimes (*please note: all Rehearsal times to be confirmed*).

Allowances can be made for major tests and lessons may sometimes be rescheduled if enough notice is given, to accommodate, for example, a whole year level excursion or incursion. The other teachers understand that the instrumental music student will have occasional absences from their regular timetabled classes due to their instrumental music lessons. However, it is each student's individual responsibility to ensure that he/she knows what learning tasks have been missed by talking to his or her teachers, and to catch up on their learning through lunchtime or home study.

There are occasional costs for the bus, accommodation, food and other associated items when we take trips to concerts and activities.
