

KINDER TO PREP TRANSITION

Term 4, 2009

During Term 4, Edenhope College will run a Transition Program for the students enrolled to commence school in 2010. Miss Kim Thornton, our 2010 Prep Teacher will provide structured activities designed to show students that school is fun. These activities will also give her an opportunity to see what the students already know and what may need to be taught the following year.

The students will be in their 2010 classroom and will stay until lunchtime. A diary of events will be sent home each week giving parents the opportunity to discuss what will be happening at school on each Transition Day. The diary also gives parents a detailed account of lessons and teaching themes each week. If you have enrolled your child at Edenhope College, the first of these diaries will be posted to you the week before the Transition Days begin. Then each week we will send the next diary home along with a copy of the College Newsletter *Whytalla*.

The Transition Days will be on:

- Friday 16 October
- Friday 23 October
- Friday 30 October
- Friday 6 November
- Friday 13 November
- Friday 20 November
- There is also a whole school Transition Day to be held on Tuesday 8 December. (This is a whole day at school in our class groups for 2010.)



The students will become accustomed to their classroom and the playground during the Transition Days. They will participate in activities with older students and get to know their teachers for 2010.

The students will have a lunch order day.

They will also be paired up with an older student on their bus to practise bus travel if this is required.

When school commences in 2010 the new Preps will be settled and comfortable at school.
